

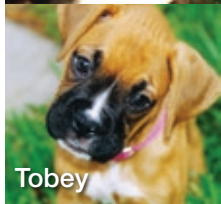

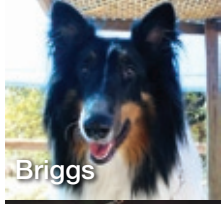

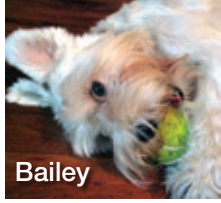

Points to remember:

- ~ While you may allow your dog to eat human food, don't allow your dog to eat other people's food
- ~ No one wants to eat next to a stinky dog. Make sure yours is reasonably clean.
- ~ Only bring well behaved human and dog friendly dogs with you.
- ~ Your dog should be up to date on all shots (carry your rabies certificate in your car)
- ~ Please only let your dog potty away from busy visible areas and clean up after your dog!
- ~ Not everyone loves dogs (yes, I know).
- ~ Not everyone has common sense. Don't be afraid to correct people for the sake of your dog if they are yanking on, touching, or feeding your dog against your wishes

Tips for Treat Training:

- Put some small, tasty treats in a baggy or your pocket.
- When you want Daisy to sit, hold a treat a bit above her head & say "sit."
- Hold a treat so that she has to put her rump on the floor to watch it.
- Give her the treat and praise her for a "good sit."
- Repeat three or four times, then quit 'til tomorrow.

Reinforce the sit command at mealtimes by holding her food dish above her head, telling her to sit, & then (and only then) put the dish on the floor.

Don't forget to praise as you give her the treat so she associates your melodic voice with the pleasure of food.

- Flea season is March through October in Central Texas!
- In one day a flea can bite your dog more than 400 times.
- Fleas can cause dermatitis, permanent hair loss, tapeworm, anemia, and even death.

Treatment:

- It is best to treat your dog at the beginning of flea season annually
- Products range from oral medication to collars, sprays, dips, and "spot-on" treatments
- Always read and understand the label of any product you use on your dog
- If your pet shows symptoms of illness after treatment, call your veterinarian
