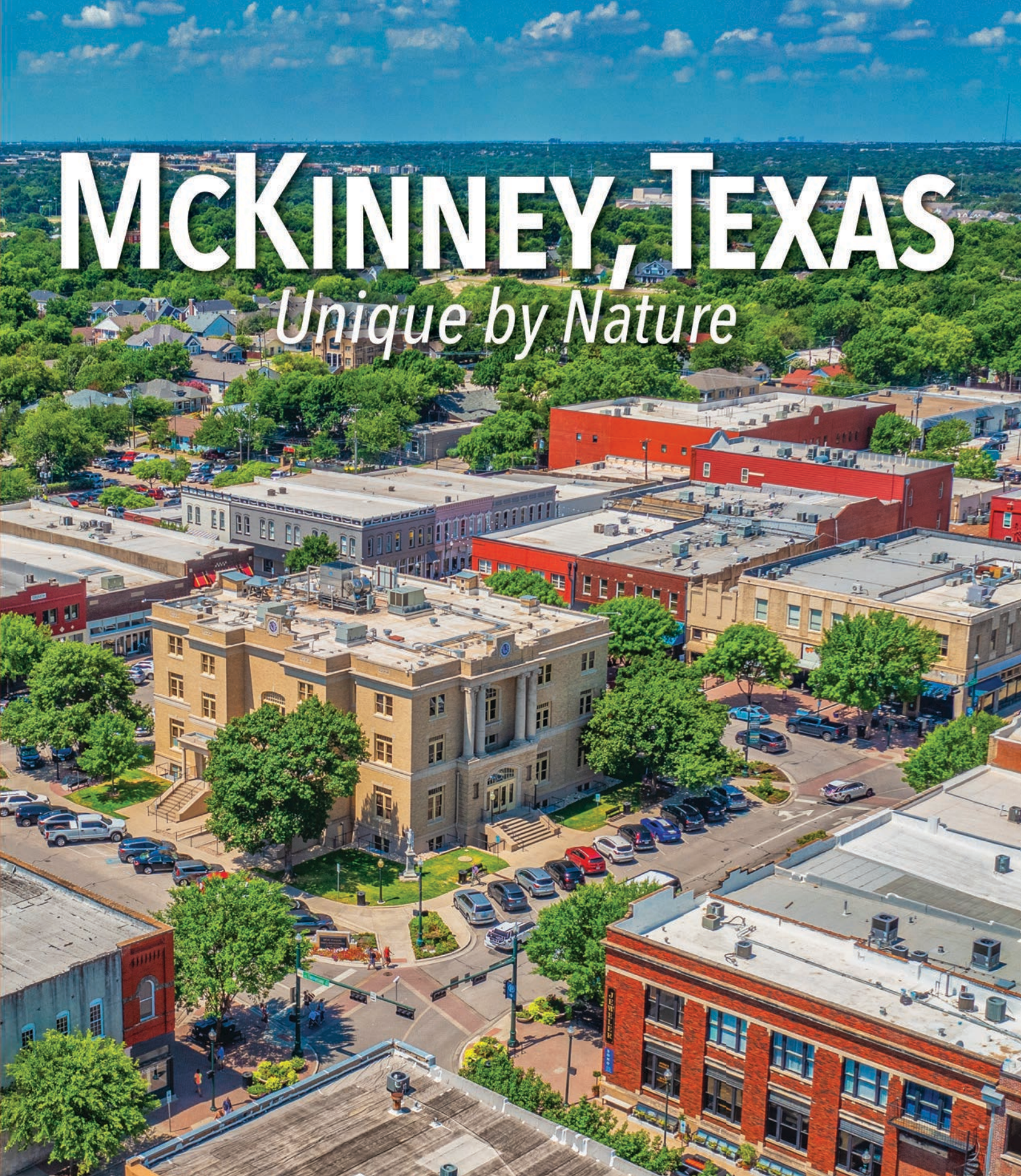

# McKinney, Texas

McKinney is a city in Collin County, Texas, United States, and the second in population to Plano. It is part of the Dallas-Fort Worth metropolitan area, and is located about 31 mi north of Dallas. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the city's 2010 population was 131,117 making it the nineteenth most populous city in the state of Texas.

William Davis donated the land that makes up McKinney in 1849, ten short years later McKinney was incorporated. Named after Collin McKinney, signer of the Texas Declaration of Independence and congressman for the Republic of Texas, McKinney is one of the fastest growing cities in the nation. The town prides itself on being ranked number one on the Best Places to Live in the United States list in the 2014 issue of CNN's Money magazine along with McKinney North High School's area ranked football team.

The Dr Pepper StarCenter in McKinney at Craig Ranch has two sheets of ice, a full-service StarStuff pro shop, a snack bar and four meeting rooms. The StarCenter is also home to two hockey associations -- the McKinney Ice Hockey Club and the Texas Aces. The facility also features beginner leagues for youth and adult hockey players run by the Dallas Stars, advanced adult hockey leagues, a Learn-to-Skate program, figure skating, birthday parties, public skating, and much more.

## Community Parks

### Bonnie Wenk Park & Dog Park

The park is approximately 250 acres along the Wilson Creek greenbelt. It includes a dog park, concrete trails, restrooms, onsite parking, amphitheater with stage, and lake.

### Veterans Memorial Park

The park features a Wall of Honor with the inscribed names of Collin County servicemen and women who sacrificed their lives in defense of our freedom, while honoring all veterans. A lighted American flag flies 24 hours a day over the wall. A fountain at the base of the flagpole symbolically waters Shumard Red Oak trees (water restrictions allowing) representing each branch of the Armed Services. A ribbon-like walkway extends from one end to the other.
