Did you know?

- **Boerne could be Tusculum:** Original settlers well versed in Latin named the settlement "Tusculum" after the hometown of the Roman philosopher Cicero. The name only lasted a few years before being changed to Boerne in 1852 after the German poet, Ludwig Borne.
- **Organized by Karl Dienger in 1860,** The Boerne Village Band is the oldest continuously operating band outside of Germany.
- **In the early 1800's Boerne was a major health destination.** Sisters of the Incarnate Word founded the St. Mary's Sanitarium for pulmonary patients.
- **Berges Fest began in 1967** as an ice cream social and music festival.
- **Holy stalagmites!** There is a natural living cavern only minutes away with an average temperature of 66 degrees year around. Visit Cave Without a Name!
- **Filmmakers love Boerne's full service Old West town!** 183 film shoots to date. Step back into the Wild West at Enchanted Springs Ranch. Shows include a world champion gun twirler, exotic animal park and tractor wagon rides.
- **Boerne's Rare 1614 Low German Bible** once sat in a closet at Boerne High School until found by a librarian while cleaning in 1983. Today this rare Bible has been identified as one of only six in the world. Low German (Platt Deutsch) is rarely spoken today.....The Bible is on permanent display in the Patrick Heath Library.

Seven Signs You're from Boerne:

Others call it "Main Street", but you know it's really "Hauptstrasse." Populated with charming shops, favorite restaurants, and other local digs, this historic stretch of the original Boerne feels like a blast from the past.

You remember Boerne when it was ... smaller. Whether you've been a Boerne resident for 30 years or 5 years, you've been able to see measurable growth during your stay. In 1980, the population was 3,229. Currently the population is 17,000+.

Fredericksburg gets way more Hill Country street cred ... but you know the truth. Though their peaches are indeed unparalleled, Boerne's Hill Country charm is just as alluring, and a little less touristy.

You've been spooked (or spooked someone else!) with the local ghost stories. In a town as old as Boerne, there's bound to be more than one goosebump-worthy tale! The Dienger Building and Ye Kendall Inn are the most popular "haunted" locations in the area.

You recall the days when the only stoplight was on Main Street. Life (and traffic) were a little simpler in those days.

To save time, sometimes you just say "San Antonio" when people ask you where you're from ... because almost inevitably, they won't know a thing about Boerne.

You enjoy quirky, historic architecture. Although gorgeous subdivisions continue to pop up in and around Boerne, the classic German architecture and old homes remain a favorite among locals.
