Colleyville is a city and wealthy suburb of Fort Worth located in northeast Tarrant County, Texas, United States. Located roughly 9.5 miles from Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport. Emerging from a number of small, rural settlements along the Cotton Belt Route, Colleyville was established in the early 20th century for Dr. Lilburn H. Colley, a prominent area physician and a veteran of the Union Army.

Colleyville Nature Center

Cotton Belt Trail

The Cotton Belt Trail is a regional trail, connecting the cities of North Richland Hills, Hurst, Colleyville and Grapevine. Browning Drive (N. Richland Hills) to Ira E. Woods Ave. at Ball St. (Grapevine)

Kidsville Playground at City Park

Kimzey Park
