Aquatics Center

Barney Wood Bark Park

Don Showman Park

10 acre park featuring a playground, recreation center, ball fields, basketball, drinking fountains, picnic area, restrooms, walking path, grills, and waterpark

Farmers Branch Park

14 acre park featuring ball fields, playground, drinking fountain, picnic area, restrooms, 0.56 mile paved jogging/walking path, horseshoes, benches, grills, and shelter

Gussie Field Watterworth Park

12 acre park featuring basketball courts, playground equipment, tennis courts, public restrooms, shuffleboard, jogging/walking paths, park space, horseshoes, benches, beautiful landscape, creek, 9 picnic tables, 1 large grill, shade shelter, outdoor lighting, electricity, and home of the Farmers Branch Rose Gardens! Which provide a beautiful backdrop for weddings, receptions, luncheons, parties, and tea time!

Historical Park
2540 Farmers Branch Lane
The Farmers Branch Historical Park is a historic building museum nestled on 27 acres that traces more than 175 years of proud Farmers Branch history. The museum complex consists of over a dozen structures, two original to the property, with the remaining from Farmers Branch and surrounding communities or reconstructed at the park. These historic buildings represent the 1840-1940 time period.

John F. Burke Nature Preserve
1111 Valley View Lane
A 104-acre tract of land representing a partnership between The City of Farmers Branch, the Valwood Improvement Authority, and the North Texas Tollway Authority. The preserve is a unique ecosystem comprising upland forests and wetlands along the Elm Fork of the Trinity River in the heart of the urban Metroplex. Visitors have access to a boardwalk overlook, a granite trail along the pond loop, two new river access points for fishing, wildlife viewing points, rest points, and restrooms.

Joya Oran Good Park
13201 Tom Field Road
Joya is part of the Oran Good Park Complex that includes baseball and softball fields, a turf soccer field, trails and rawhide creek. Joya is an inclusive glow-in-the-dark playground that, while fun in the daytime, comes alive at night with interactive features that glow, allowing for day and evening play. Featuring a 27 ft sphere with six levels of climbing, hammocks, and light panels, along with slides and a dense mesh enclosure, a tot playground, a main playground with an obstacle course, spin zone, glow seating, and more, plus the park includes amenities such as handicap accessible restrooms, walking paths, shade structures and bench seating and a built in sound system!

Liberty Plaza
12700 N. Stemmons Freeway
A park dedicated to the heroism and patriotism of our veterans and active service members. The park was established in 2007 as a place to rest, reflect and celebrate America and those who have defended our freedom.

Montgomery Park
2807 Amber Lane
Multi-sport park with sand volleyball courts with lights for evening play, a soccer field with goals, four cabanas each with a picnic table, fan, grill, automatic lights, and bluetooth speakers, and future plans for pickleball courts!

Phillip Shelby Hemstock Skate Park
14050 Heartside Place
Features a four-foot-tall pyramid with an attached three-foot bank to stair component with railings, a four-foot-wide, 22-foot-long mini half pipe with a grind rail and a bank hip, a five-foot-tall by 8-foot-wide quarter pipe with a grind rail, three grind rails, two bank to ledge and a grind box ledge combos, and two skate benches.

Rawhide Park
13701 Rawhide Pkwy
20 acre exercise course, playground, drinking fountain, 3 loop jogging/walking paths, benches, landscaping, creek, and rose garden.

Skate Park
14032 Heartside Place
Skate park featuring roller hockey, grind rails, half pipe, grind box, restrooms, and drinking fountain

Temple Trails Park
12800 Templeton Trail
6.4 acre park featuring a playground, tennis, picnic area, drinking fountains, 0.30 miles jogging/walking path, benches, creek, grills
The Grove | 12700 Denton Drive
Seasonal Farmers Market featuring the Dart Rail Station, rose gardens, a picnic area, drinking fountain, a covered stage and dance floor, yard games, grill, and adjacent parking.
