The King William Fair is a family fair with art and craft vendors, live music and dance on five stages, food and beverage booths, a Kids Kingdom play area and a small but quirky parade, all on the streets of the historic district with its stately homes and gracious gardens.

FIESTA FLAMBEAU PARADE

4/27

The 2019 Fiesta Fleambeau Parade will celebrate with "Reflections of Music Past" as the parade theme. It is the largest illuminated night parade and the highlight of Fiesta. Leading our parade for its 71st year is our premier band, The University of Texas Longhorn Band, followed by spectacular themed floats, marching units, local, out of town and out of state bands, dance groups, equestrian units and many other attractions that create a memorable night of illuminated entertainment.
