Bardwell Lake

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District welcomes you to Bardwell Lake, located in Ennis, Texas. There mission: to provide flood damage reduction to the Ellis County area, and to offer some of the best fishing, camping and boating in Texas. The lake is located northwest of Rice and west of the town on Ennis.

Cedar Creek Lake

The fourth largest lake in Texas with over 320 miles of shoreline, is located just one hour southeast of the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex. The majority of the shoreline is privately owned, however Tom Finley Park was established by TRWD as an open to the public day use waterfront park. It is managed by Friends of Cedar Creek Lake and a small admission charge is required. Tom Finley Park includes an ADA boat ramp, picnic spots, a swimming area and great fishing opportunities.

Lake Palestine

The lake is synonymous with rugged Texas beauty, clear water, and an elegant way of life. This laid-back neighborhood offers boating, skiing, fishing, and camping. Five marinas placed strategically around the water edge makes for easy boat maintenance and storage. Located Northeast of Rice west of Tyler, Texas.

Richland-Chambers Reservoir, Texas

Richland-Chambers Reservoir is the third largest inland reservoir by surface area and the 8th largest reservoir by water volume in Texas. Located southeast of Rice and the town of Corsicana. The reservoir is a venue for outdoor recreation, including fishing, boating, and swimming.
