Facebook Messenger

Keep your friends and family close with unlimited 1:1 and group video calls. Host group video calls with up to 8 people, with high-quality audio, high definition video, and interactive video features like face filters. Works across devices (smartphones and desktop).



Glide

Glide combines the convenience of texting with the expressiveness of video chat. Now you and your friends and family can share real moments as they happen and enjoy quality facetime. Share videos with friends and family from everywhere to anywhere with a tap!



Google Hangouts

Use Hangouts to keep in touch. Message friends, start free video or voice calls, and hop on a conversation with one person or a group.



Houseparty

Houseparty makes connecting face-to-face effortless, alerting you when your friends are “in the house” and ready to chat so you can jump right into the conversation. Likewise, your friends will know you’re in the app and ready to chat, so they can join you.



JusTalk

Marco Polo

The makers of Marco Polo call the app a “video walkie-talkie.” Messages are sent immediately and are available for the recipient to view and respond to almost instantly—if that’s what you want. Instead of talking in real time, you take turns leaving videos for each other. The app has many fun features, including filters that can change the sound of your voice. You can also draw and write on videos to personalize them.



Skype
